Trinity Bettendorf is a one of four full-service hospitals in a regional integrated healthcare delivery system spanning two states and covering the Quad Cities region. 340B savings bolster a variety of community needs.

**Sustaining and Expanding Access to Healthcare** 

340B savings are used in part to maintain these services:

- Medication Assistance. In 2023, **516 patients** received \$94,467 in free medications as part of our Meds-to-Beds program.
- Transportation Services. To encourage timely access to appointments and ensure a safe return home, patients received \$122,685 in free transportation, including cab fare, bus tickets, and wheelchair van transports, in 2023.
- Financial Assistance Counselors. Lack of health insurance is a barrier to care that can result in poor health outcomes and unnecessary emergency department visits. Financial assistance counselors enrolled more than 6,300 people in Iowa Medicaid and 1,500 people in Iowa Marketplace products. They also assisted more than 10,000 people with the application process.
- Maternal and Child Health Services. Among initiatives to reduce low birth weights, Trinity offered free pre-natal education classes to more than 500 participants in 2023.
- Medicine in the Barbershop. Piloted in a Davenport barbershop catering to the Black community, Trinity supplies educational materials and support to equip a health information station. This includes an iPad and other resources on diseases (like diabetes and heart disease) as well as tools to measure blood pressure and do hands-on CPR.
- Quad Cities Community Veterans Engagement Board (CVEB). Trinity facilitates and co-chairs this advisory committee. Its 2023 Veterans Experience Action Center event in Davenport attracted 500+ participants and facilitated access to services, including mental health services, suicide prevention, and free dental screenings.

Trinity – Quad Cities uses **Contract Pharmacies** to enable patient access to affordable medications and support many patient programs. *Manufacturer restrictions on contract pharmacies threatens more than \$3.3 million from our communities.* Savings that would have supported patient programs are instead retained by drug manufacturers.
